

Travel Restrictions to India

The Indian government has imposed the following entry restrictions:

- All existing visas, except diplomatic, official, UN/International Organisations, employment, project visas, are suspended till 15th April 2020. This will come into effect from 1200 GMT on 13th March 2020 at the port of departure.
- Visa free travel facility granted to OCI card holders is suspended until April 15th 2020. This will come into effect from 1200 GMT on 13th March 2020 at the port of departure.
- All incoming travellers, including Indian nationals, arriving from or having visited China, France, Germany, Iran, Italy, Republic of Korea, and Spain after 15th February 2020 shall be quarantined for a minimum period of 14 days. This will come into effect from 1200 GMT on 13th March 2020 at the port of departure.
- Incoming travellers, including Indian nationals, are advised to avoid non-essential travel and are informed that they can be quarantined for a minimum of 14 days on their arrival in India.
